    - 1. Land with full public access intended to provide recreation opportunities beyond those supplied by neighborhood parks. Community parks are larger in scale than neighborhood parks but smaller than regional parks.
  - ii. Neighborhood
    - 1. Publicly-owned land intended to serve the recreation needs of people living or working within one-half mile radius of the park.
  - iii. Mini park/plaza
    - 1. Small neighborhood park of approximately one acre or less.
  - iv. Open space
    - 1. Any parcel or area of land or water that is essentially unimproved and devoted to an open space use for the purposes of (1) the preservation of natural resources, (2) the managed production of resources, (3) outdoor recreation or (4) public health and safety.
  - v. Recreation Facility
    - 1. A public facility in which educational, therapeutic and/or recreational programs are provided. Community centers in the City of Santa Clara include the Santa Clara Senior



Center, Santa Clara Teen Center, the Walter E. Schmidt Youth Activity Center, and Santa Clara Community Recreation Center in Central Park.

1. Preschools that exist as a program under SCUSD were categorized by their corresponding programs;
  2. Preschools that operate as a non-profit on a SCUSD campus were recorded independently
    - a. Private school that shares property with a public school: Laurelwood Elementary School
      - i. [Laurelwood Preschool Co-Op - nonprofit](#)
        1. Laurelwood Preschool has been a positive first school experience for three and four year olds in our community since 1965. Laurelwood Preschool is a private, non-profit, non-sectarian, parent cooperative organization. The teachers and parents are dedicated to creating an engaging classroom environment that fosters a lifetime love of learning.
    - b. Private school that shares property with two public schools: Buscher Middle School and Washington Open Elementary
      - i. Santa Clara Parents' Nursery
        1. Our nursery school was organized in 1956 and first used the facilities of Napredak Hall on Lawrence Road. In April 1957, the school moved to Bethany Lutheran Church in Santa Clara. We moved to our present building in April 1958; however, at that time the building was located at 385 North Monroe Street. The building was moved to its present site at 471 North Monroe Street in the Fall of 1960. In Spring 1973, the Santa Clara Unified School District granted the nursery school an additional 30 feet along the south side of the play yard, and in 1985 we were granted an additional 15 feet. This added space was landscaped to provide an open area for the children's play.

We have a license agreement with the Santa Clara Unified School District for the use of the property. It stipulates that the nursery school is responsible for the maintenance of the building and its grounds.

Our nursery school was sponsored by the Santa Clara High School District until the 1965-66 school year. At that time we came under the auspices of the newly reorganized San Jose Metropolitan Adult Education Program (MAEP). During the Summer of 1967, the nursery school chose to withdraw the day program from MAEP.

For many years the school was affiliated, in part, with Santa Clara Adult Education (SCAE). Due to budget cuts in the spring of 2009 the school is now on its own as a non-profit, non-discriminatory nursery school licensed by the State Department of Health and functioning under its rules and standards.

  - a. Although both St. Justin School and Central Park Elementary STEAM (formerly Milikin School) both border Central Park, the border between Central Park and St. Justin School appears to be fenced and thus less conducive to interaction between these two spaces.
